We are learning

Maths: We are learning about graphs. Students are practising how to plot points, draw straight-line graphs, and interpret information from different types of graphs. This links to the national curriculum focus on using algebra and coordinates to describe relationships and solving problems by representing them visually.

English GCSE: The lessons this half term are on reading, looking for explicit and implicit information explaining the writer's choice of language

English Entry level 3:
Our focus is on speaking and listening and reading this half term around the topic of Charities.

Science: We are learning about the human organ systems, focusing on the heart and lungs. Students are exploring how these organs work together in the circulatory and respiratory systems to transport oxygen and nutrients around the body. This links to the national curriculum aim of understanding how the body's systems interact to keep us healthy.

Computing: Spreadsheets – Students are learning how to use and create spreadsheets for real world situations.

Preparation for adulthood: Students are learning about setting and achieving goals. They are practising how to identify what they want to achieve, break this down into smaller steps, and reflect on their progress. This supports the national curriculum focus on developing personal wellbeing, resilience, and career skills, helping young people to plan for their future and work towards their aspirations.
