

THE FENESTRATION SECTOR

The fenestration industry is currently estimated to be worth over £6 billion and is made up of glass, window and door companies who produce a whole range of products all fitted into domestic or commercial properties.

The types of companies operating in the industry include manufacturers, installers, media, marketing, IT technologies, warehousing, logistics, import and export, association bodies and training providers.

The industry is driven primarily by manufacture and installation and therefore job types would suit practical and hands on skills, although there are also a great deal of opportunities for design, IT and technology.

The industry is very innovative and is driven constantly by new product development, increasingly using biometrics and smart technology.
